- Derbyshire CC Highways has taken no enforcement action over the illegal diversion of Bramley Lane when the back face of Backdale "unexpectedly" collapsed

-Environment Agency has failed to take action over the lagoon leakages

**Put the dates for 13-23 May Inquiry in your diary:** The presence of a large number of supporters at the Backdale Inquiry demonstrated the strength of public opinion on this issue and was noted by the media. We need at least the same support in May.
